An Afternoon with Renowned Pine Barrens Author and Ecologist Howard Boyd

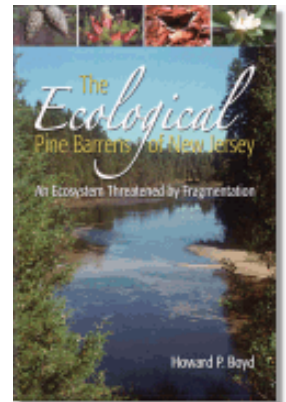
